Very deep purple-black colored, the 2009 Cambrian Shiraz is profoundly scented of blackberry preserves, black cherry compote, blueberry pie filling and licorice with nuances of cinnamon stick and vanilla pod. Big, concentrated and very full bodied in the mouth, it gives a good backbone of crisp acid and firm, medium grained tannins, finishing long and spicy. Delicious now, it should develop nicely over the next 4-6 years and drink to 2019+
